<u>Delegation of Authority--Center for Nanomaterials and Nanodevices (CNN), Phase III, Riverside Campus</u>

Under Standing Order of The Regents 100.4 (dd), the President is authorized to execute on behalf of the Corporation all contracts and other documents necessary in the exercise of the President's duties, including documents to solicit and accept pledges, gifts, and grants. On March 10, 1995, the Chancellors were delegated the authority to solicit and accept extramural grants and contracts for research not exceeding \$5,000,000 in direct costs in any one project year (DA 2036).

Pursuant to the President's authority, the University has executed a new contract from the Defense Microelectronics Activity, in the amount of \$9,190,500.00 for a twelve-month period, commencing on September 27, 2006, for the project named above.

Effective immediately, as Chancellor of the Riverside campus, you are authorized to solicit and execute any amendments, modifications, or renewals subsequent to the initial award provided the general intent and purpose of the program remain unchanged from those originally approved.
