Repatriation Coordinator

Delegation of Authority – Authority to Act as NAGPRA Repatriation Coordinator

This position of Repatriation Coordinator is authorized to act within the parameters of the UC Native American Cultural Affiliation and Repatriation Policy (NAGPRA Policy) for which this role is responsible.

Under Section IV.B. of the NAGPRA Policy, effective January 1, 2022, the Chancellor is responsible for designating a “Repatriation Coordinator” to “carry primary responsibility to accomplish compliance with the Policy, including Consultation with Tribes, Repatriation, Disposition, and tribal access to Human Remains and Cultural Items.” The duties of the Repatriation Coordinator are further described in Section IV.B of the policy; including developing positive working relationships with Tribes and upholding responsibilities for campus compliance with the federal Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act (NAGPRA), its accompanying regulations, and California NAGPRA (CalNAGPRA).

The Repatriation Coordinator will report to the Chancellor, which incorporates the “Chancellor’s Designee” as described under Section IV.B.1 of the Policy, and thus the Repatriation Coordinator reports to the Chancellor’s NAGPRA Designee.

This delegation formally documents your authority to act in all capacity in the above-referenced role of Repatriation Coordinator in fulfillment of the NAGPRA Policy.

This authority may not be further redelegated without pre-approval by the Chancellor or the Chancellor’s NAGPRA designee.
