RE: Delegation of Authority--Endowed Chair Appointments and Reappointments

In accordance with APM 191, Policy on Endowed Chairs and Professorships and the related Administrative Guidelines and Procedures, the President is authorized to approve the establishment and naming of endowed chairs and professorships, with consultation with the Academic Senate and in accordance with the University Policy and Procedures on Naming University Properties, Programs, and Facilities. Section C of the Administrative Guidelines and Procedures provides that appointments to endowed chairs are made by campuses in accordance with regular procedures for faculty appointments. Under APM 200-24, Appointment and Promotion, Chancellors are authorized to approve all appointments and reappointments of academic personnel. I have re-delegated to the Provost the authority to approve new faculty appointments (CHA0078P&EVC).

I hereby re-delegate to you, in your position as Executive Vice Chancellor and Provost, the authority to approve appointments and reappointments to endowed chairs. Appointments to administrative chairs will continue to be automatic upon appointment to the administrative position (per APM 191-C-3).

This authority may be re-delegated.
