Delegation of Authority—Writing Off Disallowed Sponsored Project Charges

In a letter, dated January 7, 2008, (DA2195), the President delegated to Chancellors, subject to the terms of the Standing Orders of The Regents 100.4 (x), the authority to fund disallowed claims of any amount that arise from performance of sponsored projects. Effective as of the above date, I hereby re-delegate to the Vice Chancellor of Planning and Budget (VC-PB) the aforementioned authority.

Costs charged to sponsored funds that will not be collected from the sponsor or that which must be refunded for reasons of unallowability, unallocability, a dispute with the sponsor, or other reasons, must be paid from University unrestricted funds. Funds received from the federal government in reimbursement of indirect costs are University unrestricted funds and may be used to fund such disallowed claims.

This delegation supersedes all previous delegations on the subject. Any re-delegation of this authority must be in writing.
