Re-Delegation of Authority—Approve Exceptional Faculty Recruitment Allowances up to \$150,000 under the Faculty Recruitment Allowance Program (APM - 190 Appendix E)

In a letter, dated August 9, 2017 (<u>DAAA01</u>), the University of California (UC) Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs delegated to each Chancellor the authority to approve exceptional allowances up to a total of \$ 150,000 per recipient under the Faculty Recruitment Allowance Program, <u>APM - 190</u>, <u>Appendix E</u>. The primary purpose of the Faculty Recruitment Allowance is to provide support for housing costs, but it may also be used to support childcare expenses, education or tuition assistance, or similar expenses.

Effective as of the date above, I hereby re-delegate to the Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor this authority subject to the conditions delineated in the letter. All exceptional allowance totals of \$150,000 or more per recipient will still require approval by the UC Office of the Provost and Executive Vice President—Academic Affairs.

This delegation supersedes all previous delegations on the subject. This authority may not be re-delegated.
